

KINGS ISLAND TRIP - SATURDAY—May 26, 2018
SPOTS ARE LIMITED AND ARE FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE
TICKETS WILL GO ON SALE MONDAY, MARCH 19, 2018

Students may begin arriving at Hurricane Middle School at 5:30a.m. We will meet in the gym. Busses will be parked in front of the building with numbers on the doors. We will be loading between 5:50 and 6:00 a.m. We will depart the school by 6:05 a.m. promptly and return approximately 12:00 a.m. on May 27, 2018. Please do not park in front of the sixth grade building: this area needs to be left clear for busses to pick up the students. As it is impossible to keep the students in groups with the teachers and agree on rides, we will use a checkpoint system in chaperoning. The chaperones will meet with the students at the Eiffel Tower at intervals and check off the names of the students. The water works will be open. You will not be allowed into the water works without a bathing suit. **Checks to HMS-- \$120.00** for entrance to park, drink band, meal band and transportation.

RULES

- All students **MUST** travel in groups of 2 or more. Any students seen walking alone (this even applies to the restroom) will be assigned to a teacher for the rest of that checkpoint time and will receive After School Detention next school year and risk not being allowed to go on the next trip.
- All students **MUST** report **PROMPTLY** to checkpoint. Failure to do so will result in being assigned to a teacher and after School Detention next school year. In addition they may not be allowed to go the following year. **YOU MUST CHECK IN WITH YOUR CHAPERONE.**
- Students need to act responsibly. Remember you are representing HMS.
- You may wear shorts-not too short nor too tight. No halter tops. Follow the HMS Dress Code.
- Electronic are allowed--- **However, you are responsible for them.**
- All students should bring a change of clothes for the return trip as the students get wet on several of the rides
- If you leave items in lockers we will not be going back in to get them.
- Once the water park closes you will not be able to return to that area to retrieve your belongings.
- Please be aware that flip flops often break and that Kings Island prices are high. Last year a pair of flip flops was \$20.00 and you **MUST** wear shoes at the Park!!!!
- Students will be allowed to bring snacks; however, they need to limit drinks. **THEY MAY TAKE SCREW TOP PLASTIC DRINK CONTAINERS ONLY; NO CANS OR GLASS BOTTLES.**
- **DO NOT DRINK MONSTER/ENERGY DRINKS**

Any student who is arrested by Kings Island security personnel for shoplifting will be held by the authorities until parents are notified and can appear in person to obtain their child's release. Shoplifting is a serious offense at any age and the school cannot assume responsibility when students break the law. HMS staff is not permitted to wait with a student who chooses to shoplift and we will not hold 300 students and 6 buses from getting home on time.

We are most concerned with the safety of the students; they must be responsible and follow the rules. Students are to be in school all day Friday May 25, 2018 to be eligible for the Kings Island trip. The absence list will be checked. Once again, we will leave promptly at 6:05 a.m. Saturday, May 26, 2018. Have a fun day!
